

## ROCK SOLID EVIDENCE

Is there any evidence to confirm the Bible? Tons of it! One of the most plentiful forms is in archaeology. Take Erastus for example. To many people he is a little-known character in the New Testament, one of the people mentioned in Paul's letters. "*Erastus, the treasurer of the city, greets you*" (Romans 16:23) said the apostle. And then again "*Erastus stayed in Corinth*" (2 Timothy 4:20). So, putting those two verses together, what do we know about him? Just this: that he was the city treasurer of Corinth in Greece.



Well, guess what! In 1929 a stone inscription to *Erastus* was discovered *in Corinth!* It was a marble paving slab which declared that he had laid this pavement at his own expense for his job as one of the cities aedile men – a job which included being *treasurer!* It seems to be more rock-solid evidence that the Bible is fact not fiction.
