Rebekah continues helping in our music ministry, nursery, kids ministries, and music lessons to girls from the church. Diego, Josué's friend, continues studying the Bible and occasionally comes to church. Please continue praying for his salvation. However, as much as we have enjoyed our time at my father's church, Eternal Rock Baptist, our time there is quickly ending. The beginning of Abundant Grace Baptist is imminent. I prepared the road map for the opening. I prayed to find a place by June, finish the remodeling by July, and finally open in August. Well, I am happy to announce that beyond our wildest dreams, we found the place in May, and last week we finished the most pressing remodeling projects! God is awesome! Not because we have a place to meet, but because He wants the Gospel be preached there! The first week of June we had a group of 10 people visiting from Lakes Pond Baptist in Waterford, CT. What a help they were! They were sent directly by God. When we planned the trip, we didn't even think we would have a place for the church. They came and did so much work that we finished everything we needed to do. Plumbing, electrical, painting, and much more was accomplished. Now, in the next few weeks we will focus on opening Bible studies for the community, ESL for the community, music, and any other outreach ideas that we may have in preparation for August 14. We have over 10,000 flyers that Striving Together printed for us, and we have another group coming from Open Door Baptist in Howell, NJ. Together we will pass these out, pray that many will come, and most importantly that many be saved. Starting August 14, on your behalf, there will be a Bible preaching church in Mexico City, and my family and I, on your behalf, will spend the rest of our lives proclaiming to all that Jesus Saves!
